

FAQS - STADIUM GOLF TOUR

So how does it work?

Choose from one of our three packages and then select a timeslot. Your tee off time will be communicated to you closer to the event. There will be a maximum of 8 guests per tee off time and you will be welcome to enjoy the course at your own leisure and pace. At the first platform you will be given your golf club and balls.

There will be nine platforms around the stadium bowl for you to test your skills and tee off from. Each hole has a thrilling setup that feels different to any other course.

How does the scoring work?

Your score will be determined by the accuracy of your tee shot at every hole.

EAGLE (-2): Hole in one

BIRDIE (-1): On or in the painted circle

PAR (E): On the target green BOGEY (+1): On the playing field

DOUBLE BOGEY (+2): Outside the playing field

How long do you expect the course to take?

Depending on how busy it will be, we would allocate a minimum of 1 hour 30 minutes to complete the course.

How will I get my tickets?

Your digital ticket(s) will be sent to you via our Twickenham ticketing app approximately **1 week** before the event. If you are new to the Twickenham Stadium app, you can search for 'Twickenham Stadium' on the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u> to download the app now. To ensure a smooth entry we encourage that you transfer tickets to each of your guests.

Can I book for children too?

Absolutely, please bear in mind that there is a fair amount of walking involved in the route.

Can I bring my own clubs?

Unfortunately not. The clubs chosen will be perfect for the distance and height needed to aim for the marked-out greens on the pitch.

Do I need golf shoes?

No, you will be walking around the public concourse and seating area of the stadium. Comfortable footwear and clothing is recommended.



Do I need any golf experience?

The event is designed for all skill levels from avid weekend golfers to those who have never picked up a club before!

What else can I do?

We will also be running stadium tours which will take you inside the England Changing Rooms and the World Rugby Museum. These can be booked direct at worldrugbymuseum.com.

What about food & drink?

We have a range of packages with options to dine at the stadium for lunch or dinner. If you want to have some food while you are here, we recommend booking the Silver package for more casual offering, or the Gold package which offers a seated lunch or dinner. Food and drink may not be brought into the stadium.

Can I buy food and drink there if I do not opt for an inclusive package?

Yes, we will have a full bar service available selling hot and cold drinks and bar food.

Is there parking?

Yes, we have complimentary parking available. You will be given a code to pre-register your car before you arrive. We will also have additional tablets on arrival for anyone who forgets. Our getting here page also provides useful information about various ways to get to us.

Is this course accessible to guests with physical accessibility requirements?

Lift access is available to all levels for those with mobility issues. There are a number steps to reach platforms 1-8. There is one wheelchair accessible platform located on the 9th hole.

Can I make a weekend of it?
