### Grogg Profile: Willie John McBride

An Irish player who captained the British and Irish Lions in their 1974 tour to South Africa.

### Grogg Profile: David Campese

An Australian rugby union player who became one of the most decorated rugby sevens players in history.

A French player who retired from international rugby with 111 caps, making him the world's most capped player at the time.

A Scottish player who made his debut against England at the age of 19.

### Grogg Profile: Sean Fitzpatrick

At the time of his retirement from international rugby in 1997, Fitzpatrick had appeared in 92 international matches for New Zealand.

Welsh rugby union player who, over the course of a 15-year career, scored 131 tries, 43 drop goals, 293 penalties and 523 conversions.
