Lesson plan

5 minutes – (starter activity) Use the PowerPoint entitled 'World Cup PPT KS1' and run through the 'Guess What!?' quiz. Using partly covered images, students must guess what they're seeing before the image is revealed.

5 minutes— Lead into asking the students what they think they're learning about today. Use the slides to help explain what rugby and the World Cup are.

5 minutes—(optional) How would you feel? Use the images of rugby players to get students to recognise the emotions displayed in the photos. Can the students empathise and think of times they've felt similarly?

30-35 minutes— Design your own world cup! Focus on texture. Students could use a variety of materials e.g. tissue paper, corrugated card, bubble wrap, cloth, felt, sponge, beads, glitter, and sequins!

3 minutes—Clean-up followed by getting students to think about the textures they've created. Is your world cup soft/rough, smooth/crinkly? Does it have layers?
