Literary Technique	Definition	Example
Synonym	Using certain words to evoke an emotional response.	Watch the Red Roses go for World Cup glory this Saturday at 5pm!
Emotive language	An exaggerated statement.	How could she let the ball slip through her hands?
Rhetorical question	Using three points to support an argument	I, you, she/he
Hyperbole	Using true statements or statistics to create a strong argument.	She's a European champion, she's a world champion and now she's an Olympic champion!
Personal pronouns	Starting a sentence with the root form of a verb to form a command, request, or forbiddance.	'Angry' and 'mad' She flew through the air!
Triples	A question asked in order to create a dramatic effect. It doesn't require an answer.	The Red Roses were <b>euphoric</b> , lifting up the world cup with <b>beaming</b> smiles.
Facts	A short word we use as a simple substitute for the proper name of a person.	They've won the Six Nations 5 times and they've been unbeaten in the last 32 games.
Imperative sentence	A word or phrase that's very similar in meaning to another word.
