WOMEN'S RUGBY:

THE WORLD CUP



KS2 Learning objectives:

- to develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space
- To learn about sport and some rugby terminology
- To empathise with emotions through sport and relate them to our own experiences







Lesson plan

5 minutes – (starter activity) Use the PowerPoint entitled 'World Cup PPT KS2' and run through the 'Guess What!?' quiz. Using the partly covered images, students must guess what they're seeing before the image is revealed.

5 minutes— Lead into asking the students what they think they're learning about today. Use the slides to help explain what rugby and the World Cup are.

5 minutes—(optional) What is each country famous for? Match the images to their corresponding country.
Students will later use the images to help inspire their world cup design.

30-35 minutes— Design your own world cup! Focus on texture. Students could use a variety of materials e.g. tissue paper, corrugated card, bubble wrap, cloth, felt, sponge, beads, glitter, and sequins!

3 minutes—Clean-up followed by getting students to think about the textures they've created. Is your world cup soft/rough, smooth/crinkly? Does it have layers?
